Music

Choir

Choir is available for all students Years 3 - 6. They have weekly rehearsals at lunch time. The choir learn a wide variety of songs, performing at special school assemblies, school musicals and combined school events including the Ryde School Spectacular.





REPS Music Program

The Ryde East Music Program provides children with a wonderful opportunity to learn an instrument.

It is administered by a sub committee of the REPS P&C, with the support of the Principal and School Staff.

Students have weekly tutorials, with private tutors, either before or after school. Lessons are held on site, in designated classrooms.

- recorder ensemble

- rock or jazz band

Ryde East Music Festival

The Ryde East Music Festival is an annual event that has been running for over 20 years.

Over 15 Schools from Sydney's Northern Districts, including REPS senior band, compete in this competition. This is a fabulous platform for students to demonstrate their musical skills.





Dance

As part of the K-6 Creative Arts syllabus, all students participate in dance lessons with their class teacher.

In Kindergarten students explore the notion that dance is about moving their bodies to express ideas. They watch dance performances and begin to recognise some basic components of dance.





Dance Groups



We have a 3-6 dance group at at Ryde East Public Still. At the beginning of each year students are eligible to audition for these group. Successful students then rehearse twice a week, before school and lunch time, under the guidance of Ms Mitchell and Miss McCarthy.

Performance opportunities include Education Week, Ryde Schools Spectacular, Sydney North Dance Festival and the State Dance Festival.



Musical



Biannually REPS holds a whole school musical.

A theme is chosen and each class choreographs and performs a dance item.

There are usually two evening performances for family and friends to come along and view the musical.

Visual Arts



Visual Arts lessons are conducted in the classroom and are taught by the classroom teacher.

Kindergarten students make pictures and artworks using a range of materials to represent real and imagined situations.

Students also have the opportunity to participate in lunch time art club. The art club runs weekly throughout the term and create artworks for a number of external projects, such as Operation Art.



Art Show

Every alternate year Ryde East Public School holds a whole school Art Show. Every child in the school produces an artwork to be hung in the gallery as well as contributing to a collaborative class art piece.

The school hall is transformed into an art gallery. There is an opening cocktail night for parents to come and view the works and bid in the silent auction.
