Library Lessons

Kindergarten visit the library once a week for a 40 minute library lesson.

In their library lesson they are read a book, learn about the different books in the library and where they are found as well as borrow books to take home.





Borrowing



Kindergarten borrow each week during their library lessons. In semester 1 the teacher provides a selection of quality literature, from popular authors that are suitable for Kindergarten children.

During Semester 2 as their knowledge of books and interests broaden they are able to borrow from both fiction and nonfiction books.

Students can also borrow and return books during their lunch breaks when the library is open.

Students need a library bag to carry books home in. Books should be returned weekly on the day of their lesson.



Book Week

Each year we celebrate book week in the library. Students and teachers celebrate their love of literature and the importance of reading.

We hold book character parades where all students come dressed as their favourite book character.

We hold book fairs in the library where students can purchase books for home or to donate to the school.

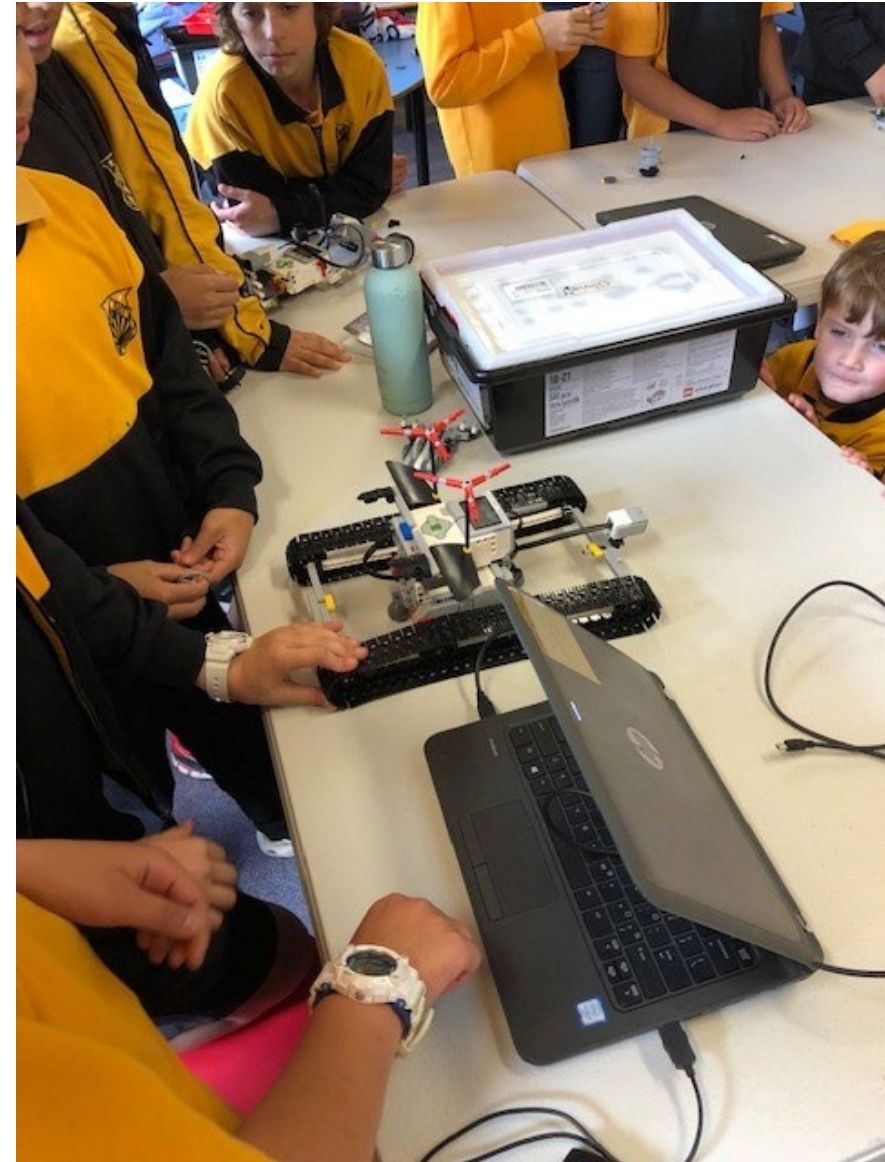


Laptops and iPads

Kindergarten students learn to logon to the computers using their unique username and password. They are able to type simple stories and locate programs, such as Reading Eggs, on the internet.

These devices are integrated across the curriculum areas.



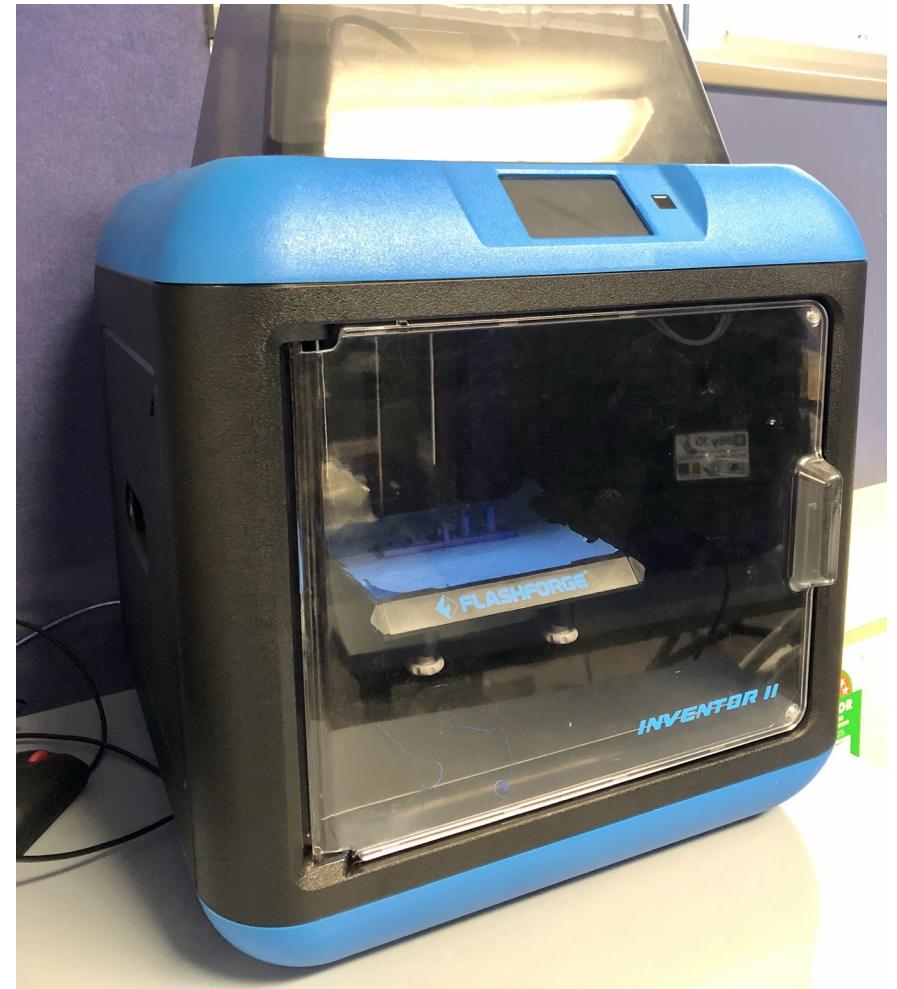

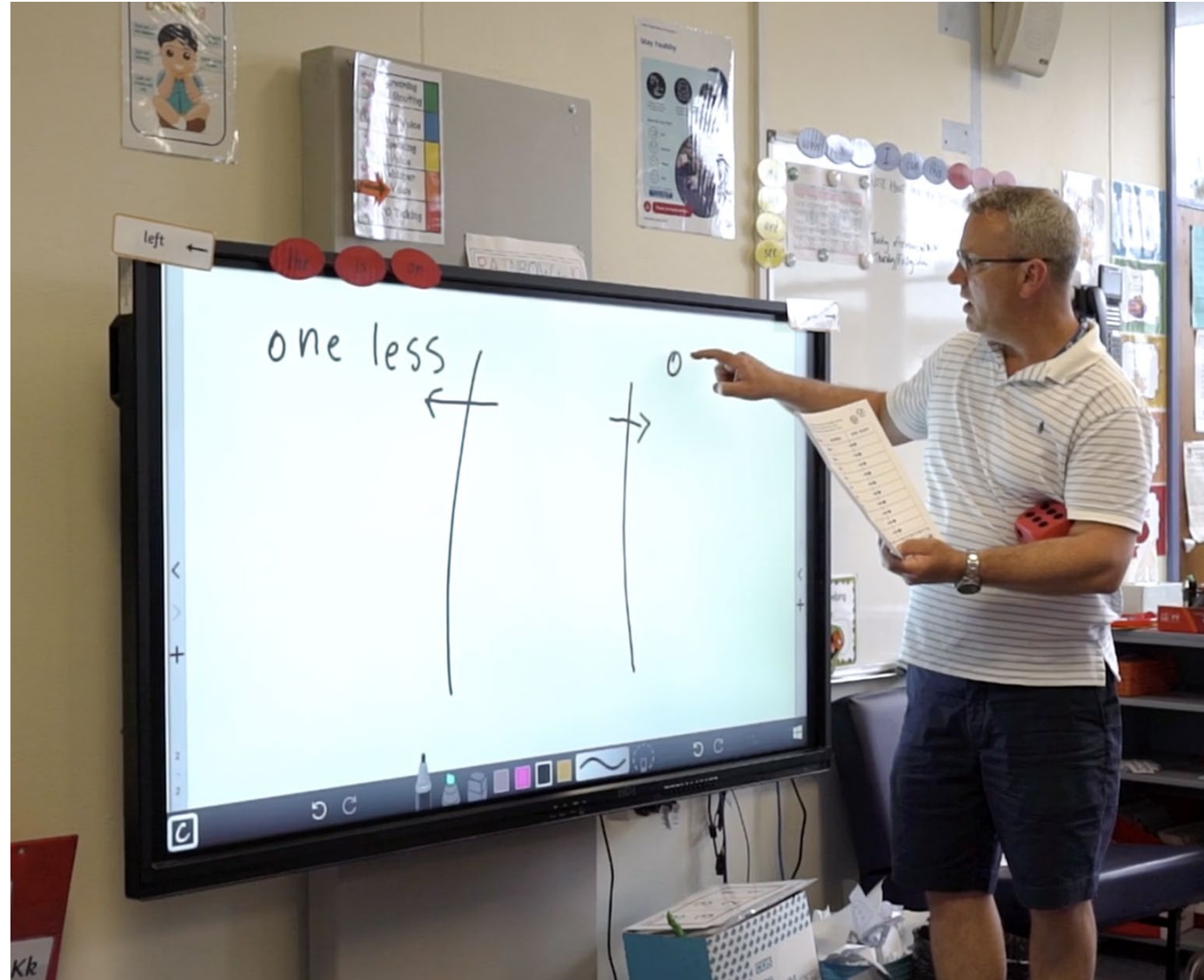
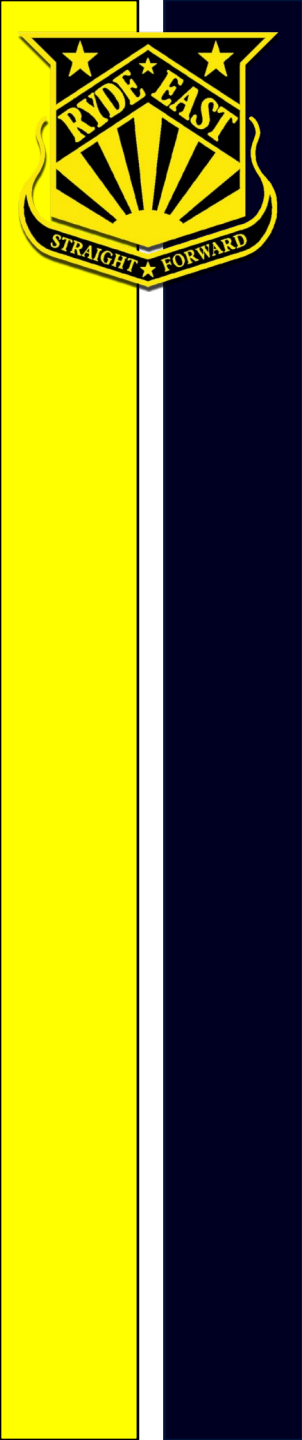


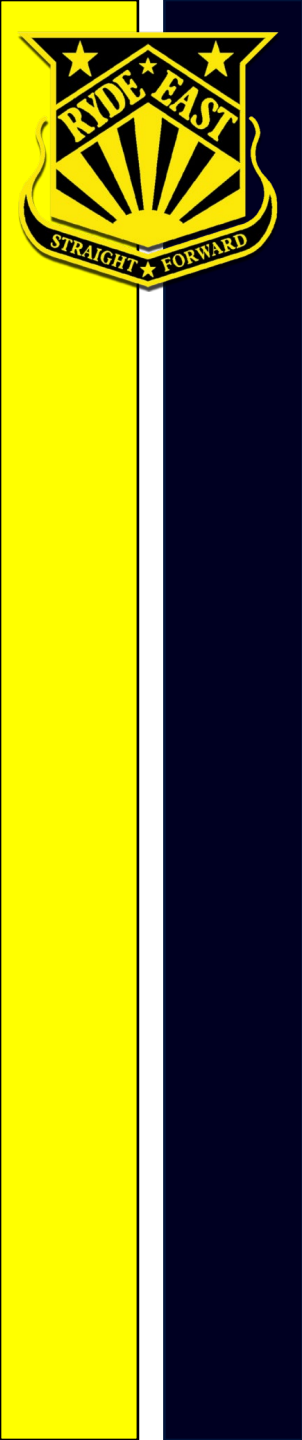


Some of the technology our Kindy students use
