Science, History and Geography








Science

Kindergarten explore the living world and the way animals and plants grow and change. They use their investigative skills to observe the world around them to note changes in weather and how it impacts their daily life and the life of animals through hibernation and migration. Students get to test a range of different materials to observe their properties. They explore floating and sinking whilst observing materials that are waterproof. Students collaborate with their peers and use the design process to find solutions to everyday problems.










Excursion Sydney Zoo

In history, Kindergarten students get to compare the past to the present.

Students compare their family heritage with others and learn to identify similarities and differences between their families.

They look at objects from the past and the present, comparing their features and looking at how things have changed over time.
