PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Changes to our Behaviour Management Procedures

After discussion with staff, we have amended our current behaviour management procedures when addressing negative behaviours with students. Previously, students were issued with either warning cards or given detention. This has been replaced with a new system where students have the opportunity to reflect on their behaviour with a focus on positively redirecting future behaviours in line with the schools' PBL Values: Respectful, Engaged, Personal best and Safe.

Students will complete a 'reflection sheet', noting ways in which they can positively resolve conflict or manage situations in the future. This discussion is done in conjunction with a teacher. If a student is to be removed from the playground, classroom or situation, they will attend the 'reflection room' where they will discuss with an executive member of staff what occurred and strategies to move forward in order to redirect behaviour. If your child attends the 'reflection room' you will be notified via telephone or letter.

Further information will be communicated.

Absences from school

As previously informed, we are going to notify you via email when your child is absent from school if you have not already contacted the office or notified the school that they are away. The email will be sent each day at approximately 10:30am through the Sentral parent portal and will go to your nominated email address.

If you have yet to update your email address through the parent portal on Sentral, please do so by the end of this week as notification will begin on Tuesday 12 June 2018. If you have shared custody of your child/ren the email will be sent to the primary caregiver, due to the setup of the system.

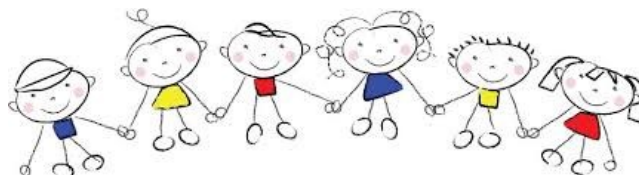
Cook for OSHC
