Staff Professional Learning

As part of our School Plan 2018-2020, Strategic Direction 1: Sustainable Evidence-based Practices, we are currently undertaking professional learning with a Mathematics consultant, Anita Chin. Anita is a leading expert in primary mathematics education. She contributed and consulted on the NSW Mathematics K-6 syllabus and delivers a deep, whole-school understanding of the Mathematics curriculum, along with innovative, enlightening teaching techniques that inspire staff and students.



Earlier this term, the staff undertook professional learning with Anita to support differentiation within the classroom and resourcing for quality teaching practices. Next Monday, Anita will be working with all staff from K-6 doing demonstration lessons in chosen classrooms to highlight quality teaching and assessment practices with an emphasis on differentiation. The aim over the next 12 months and beyond is to expose students to a range of quality teaching practices in mathematics, catering for their individual needs to improve their learning outcomes. We are all really excited to be on this journey and are looking forward to working collaboratively with experts in this area.

1S have been loving a hands-on approach to...

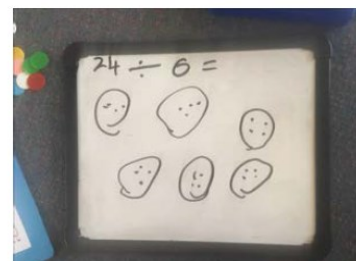


Saxon has used green counters on the top row of his tens-frame and black counters on the bottom row to model some addition problems.

These two groups are playing the 'Bundling' game. They rolled a die and added this amount of paddle pop sticks to the 'ones' section of their board. Once they covered all ten spaces, they would bundle the paddle pop sticks with a rubber band and move it to the 'tens' section. This was loads of fun!



We have just started exploring and modelling sharing problems using our sharing boards and counters. We broke up 24 counters into 2, 3, 4, 6, 8 and 12 equal groups. Using that magical number of 24 again, we then also explored our sit spot array and broke these up into 6 equal groups.



Amelie even wrote the matching number sentence (with the division symbol!!) and drew equal grouping as another way to work out this problem.



We also got outside to do some work on capacity. The children made some educated guesses about which container could hold the most amount of liquid, and then used small cups to measure each container.
