### Parent Workshop with Mr Brad Marshall

Last Thursday evening we hosted a parent information session titled 'A slow road to disconnected children'. This session attracted more than 60 parents, which was a fantastic turn out. Parents in attendance commented on the relevance of the workshop and expressed thanks in being given the opportunity to attend.

This talk provided parents with the "psychological underpinnings" that drive the addictive nature of gaming, social media and online gambling. It also armed parents with concrete strategies to manage screen time. A segment will air on the 7:30 report on the ABC in relation to this topic. Once I am informed of the date it will air, I will notify you.

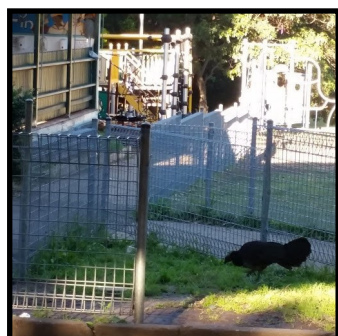


### WORKING BEE FOR YEAR 5 FAMILIES
